Explanation of New 1-7 Rating Scale for Award Nominations

1: Not at All: Nomination is mostly incomplete and difficult to review. Nominee does not meet nomination criteria.

2: Poor Nomination: Nomination has potential and meets some nomination criteria. Nomination is unorganized/ incomplete and difficult to review. Individual/program information are not clearly described. Nominee needs time for further development.

3: Weak Nomination: Nomination is complete but missing key information. Nominee has potential, but is not suitable for further review.

4: Average Nomination: Nomination is organized, but lacks detail in key areas. Innovative approach, impact, commitment and leadership are mentioned, but aren't easily identifiable, lack demonstrated evidence, and overall doesn't stand out. Applicant should be encouraged to reapply in the future.

5: Good Nomination: Nomination is organized and impact, commitment, and leadership are identifiable and success/evidence is well documented, however, nomination lacks an element of innovation. Meets award criteria in some areas of consideration.

6: Excellent Nomination: Nomination is well organized, thorough and engaging. The nominee clearly demonstrates leadership, impact, commitment and is highly innovative. Meets award criteria in several areas of consideration.

7: Outstanding Nomination: Nomination is well organized, thorough and exciting to review. The individual/program is highly innovative and demonstrates great impact, commitment, and leadership with many unique attributes. This nominee is award-winning in multiple areas of consideration.
